Detailed description on Teaching received:

First, I want to thank ESGO for this great chance to develop my knowledge; also, I want to thank Prof. Francesco Raspagliesi and his team for this period. Istituto Nazionale dei Tumori is leading center in Italy and in Europa. Every Monday and Wednesday I am attending meetings, clinical oncologist, and radiation therapist discuss patient cases and future strategies. Every Monday there are rounds, and patients that were operated and will be operated are discussed. The discussions are in Italian language; however, there is always someone who translates into English language. I also attend Italian language course, to further help me integrate and participate in the above mentioned discussions. In agreement with Dr. Raspagliesi I make presentations of patients cases in English language weekly. Nearly every day there are oncological surgery, I attend most of the operations, at least three operation per day. It is a great experience due to the high professionalism of medical stuff and a friendly atmosphere in the clinic. Laparotomy and laparoscopy approaches are performed routinely. Very often cases are with general surgeons to avoid complications.

In addition, I attend outpatient visits and follow-ups of the patients that I have attended surgeries of.
