**Detailed description on Teaching received:**

My name is Pablo Padilla, I have performed a surgical stay during the last 3 months at Charité Hospital (Berlin, Germany). I want to explain my own experience in order to evaluation for the ESGO grant.

I am very glad, to have chosen Charité to improve my surgical skills, above all in ovarian cancer. They are one of the most important centers in Europe, that focus the ovarian cancer surgery. During my stage I have learned, every different types of ovarian cancer surgery (primary and interval debulking, surgeries in relapse and palliative surgery).

In my opinion, one of the great advantages that Charite offers for a training, is the facility to know the patients as a whole, which greatly facilitates the development and the understanding of the case. Giving the chance to know the gynecologic oncology from a multidisciplinary approach.

1. Develop knowledge in the preoperative evaluation in primary and interval debulking ovarian cancer
2. Develop expertise in the management of complex and radical abdomen-pelvic surgery, including pelvis and upper abdomen
3. Develop expertise in gastrointestinal surgery in Gynecologic Oncology, including sigma-rectum resection, small bowel resection with mechanical and manual anastomosis. Develop of ostomies technique.

4. Handling upper abdomen: liver mobilization, pancreas and splenectomy, diaphragmatic peritonectomy, diaphragm injury.
5. Develop knowledge in the postoperative care in ovarian cancer surgery
6. Palliative surgery
