**Detailed description on Teaching received:**

I participated the daily routine practice of the Clinic. The staff were really helpful and they have an excellent theoretical and practical knowledge in gynecologic oncology.

In the operating theatre I could learn about new techniques, such total mesometrial resection, complete deperitonealization, nerve sparing operations, paraaortic lymphadenectomy, liver mobilisation and ureter and vessel preparation, intestine surgery. I also could observe laparoscopic surgeries, and the experience how they do is really helpful in my practice.

**Goals accomplished :**

My goal was to improve my knowledge in the surgical treatment of ovarian cancer. I had the opportunity to assist these kind of operations, and understand the aim and implementation of complete surgical debulking surgery. At the same time I could observe these patients preoperative and postoperative care. The retrograde hysterectomy technique for en bloc resection of the ovarian cancer and the total mesometrial resection for cervical cancer techniques were new for me. As the benefit of these techniques is clearly visible, I hope that I will have the possibility to use in my home institution.

**Achievement in clinical practice:**

I was involved to the operations as a first or second assistant. All of the doctors explained me the case, the proper anatomy in the abdominal cavity and showed several new ways for the surgical treatment of different gynecologic malignancies.

On the first week of my visit the host Department organized the congress: 9th International Charité-Mayo-Conference, This conference contained thematic days about different gynecological cancers. A wide range of scientific program contained several live surgeries ( laparoscopic radical hysterectomy, radical vulvectomy, en bloc resections, lymphadenectomy, upper abdominal surgery, nerve-sparing surgery) and keynote lectures from USA and Europe.
