## **Detailed description on Teaching received:**

From my first day to end of my visit at Queen Charlotte's & Chelsea Hospital, I was incorporated into all activities of gynecologic oncologist's daily schedule. The day was starting at 7.30. I have attended morning visits which the postoperative and preoperative patients in ward were evaluated, examined and discussed. This provided me to observe the routine practice of the center in preoperative and postoperative evaluation of the patients.

I spent most of my time in operating theatre. Prof. Christina Fotopoulou is one of the leading gynecological-oncologist in ultra-radical surgeries for advanced and relapsed ovarian cancer, and also in general advanced gynecological cancers. Observation, active participations in surgeries and assisting her were a big opportunity for me. I benefited a lot from her skills and techniques. I would like to thank Prof. Fotopoulou for sharing her experiences during both

postoperative follow up, radiotherapy and chemotherapy.

gynecological-oncologic team of the center. Finally I am grateful to ESGO Council for generous

support, and improving relations between clinics and countries.
