Detailed description on Teaching received:

Teaching in risk factors and early diagnosis of endometrial cancer. Hysteroscopic findings in endometrial hyperplasia. Technique of hysteroscopy. Surgical staging and treatment of Endometrial Cancer. Technique of pelvic and paraortal lymphadenectomy. Risk factors, screening methods and early diagnosis of cervical cancer. Radical hysterectomy technique. Surgical treatment of ovarian cancer.

Goals accomplished :

Upgrade of clinical skills to provide a better clinical care in the areas of diagnosis, treatment and prevention of gynecologic malignancies.

Achievement in clinical practice:

Improvement of clinical skills by exposure to a large number of patients with the entire spectrum of gynecologic cancers and complex benign gynecologic problems. Participation in radical pelvic surgeries and multidisciplinary oncologic operations. Participations in laparoscopic staging and treatment of gynecologic malignancies.

The Fellow exceeded my expectations. In order to get a better understanding of problems encountered by doctors in managing gynecologic malignancies, a longer period of fellowship would be more beneficial.

Future plan on returning to home:

I will focus on the delivery of a better clinical care to women with gynecologic malignancies. Application of minimal-invasive approaches in gynecologic cancer where applicable. A higher grade of responsibility and independence for managing all urinary and bowel complications that may result from the malignancy or from treatment complications. I will cascade the knowledge, I have got to my colleagues and maintain the contacts with Austrian doctors.

Overall evaluation and comment of the fellowship:

The travelling fellowship provided me with the opportunity to pursue clinical experiences within different areas of gynecologic oncology to be more confident in performing radical pelvic surgery and to consider the use of laparoscopy in oncology. I became more familiar with the pelvic side wall and retroperitoneal anatomy. The staff of the hosting institution was very friendly and helpful. The mentor provided me with the opportunity to participate in all oncologic operations.
