Detailed description on Teaching received: I observed all the surgeries related to gynecological oncology that were performed on Tuesday and Friday. I entered the gynecologic oncology wards in which the postoperative care of the patients was discussed. I also accompanied to the Gynecologic Ultrasound clinic assessing ovarian tumors as a part of IOTA-5 trial and the patients who had bleeding as a part of IETA trial every Monday and Wednesday, respectively. I also entered the Gynecologic Tumor Board every Thursday in which the management of approximately 30 patients with primary or recurrent tumors were discussed with the participation of radiology, pathology and radiation oncology departments.

Goals accomplished : I took the vision of a comprehensive gynecological oncology clinic in every aspects. I understood the advantages and the missing aspects of my own training

program and institution. I had the chance to discuss the requirements and conditions of being involved in international trials.

Achievement in clinical practice: To watch the surgeries, but especially the resection of paracardial tumor was useful for me. Furthermore, I found the criteria (simple rules) of IOTA trial very practical and I will use them in patient evaluation in my institution. I got a lot of new information about the ongoing trials in the tumor boards.

Problems encountered with a critical evaluation of the fellowship experience as a whole:
The language (Dutch) of the country was difficult for me.

Future plan on returning to home: I will complete my fellowship program in 3 months. When I start to work as a formal subspecialist in my new center, I will try to arrange the organization according to the necessities of being involved in the multicenter studies and I will apply for a Phd program in onco-immunology in my country or abroad.

Overall evaluation and comment of the fellowship: As a whole, this 1 month was very helpful for me to widen my vision on gynecologic oncology. The organization of the patient management, the conduction of the trials, and the scientific basis in every work performed leads me to seek the ways of being more scientific during performing my job.


