Detailed description on Teaching received:

Even from the first day of my fellowship I felt as a member of the department and was allowed to take part in the whole daily schedule. The operationteam of the director Prof. Schouli is very experienced ,well educated and talented in dealing with difficult and rare cases in gynecologic oncology and this is one of the reasons why it is correctly considered as a centre of excellence.

Especially the deputy Director of the department Dr. Muallem was very helpful, excellent educated and extremely talented operator, who helped me understand very well the anatomical relationships in the upper and lower abdomen due to the high anatomical knowledge and the excellent surgical skills, which he has. Operations such as Complete Debulking and especially his method of complete deperitonealization and en bloc resection, which was really impressing, laparoscopic nerve – sparing radical hysterectomy for Cervical Cancer, Laparoscopic Hysterectomy and Pelvic and Paraortal Lymphadenectomy for Endometrial Cancer, Radical Vulvectomy and Lymphadenectomy in Vulva Cancer, took place every day in Charite – Campus Virchow Klinikum.
