Detailed description on Teaching received:

- Performance of ultrasound examinations for diagnosis and staging of gynecological tumors 2 days a week under direct supervision of Prof. Fischerova
- Performance of transvaginal and transabdominal ultrasound guided biopsies under supervision of senior consultants
- Support of Prof. Fischerova in writing a consensus paper on ultrasound diagnostics in vulvar cancer, proofing literature, collecting images, videos, and schemes, communicating and exchanging ideas with colleagues abroad.
- Participation to tumorboards and observation in surgical theater

Goals accomplished:

Substantial improvement in diagnostic skills and preparation of the above-mentioned consensus paper.

Research performed and outcome:

Understanding of the anatomy of the groins (with dissection at the local anatomical institute) and performance of serial sonographic examinations of the groins to be able to prepare the consensus paper on methodology, terms and definitions of sonographic nodal staging in vulvar cancer patients

Terms, definitions and measurements to describe the sonographic features of inguinal lymph nodes in patients with vulvar cancer: a consensus opinion from the Vulvar International Tumor Analysis (VITA) group

Even if I could communicate with patients in a basic way, language remains a big issue for foreigners attending a training in Czech Republic. I thank my colleagues for having been so kind to integrate with English. The Coronavirus outbreak in March has been an unexpected difficulty as for everybody.
