Dear members of ENYGO,

By way of introduction, I am Khayal Gasimli and would like to apply for a position of ENYGO National Representatives (NATREPs) from Germany.

After successfully completing my medical studies at the Charité Medical University of Berlin, I started my career as a research fellow in the Tumor Bank Ovarian Cancer (TOC) at the Charité Virchow- Klinikum Campus. During my research fellowship, I was involved in national and international studies. In my doctoral thesis supervised by, Prof. Dr. med. Jalid Sehoul, I

investigated the clinical significance of peritoneal cancer in advanced ovarian cancer. My research aimed at clarifying the exact staging in the initial diagnosis of peritoneal carcinosis of ovarian origin and identifying different tumor involvement patterns. I also examined the prognostic and predictive values of the Peritoneal Cancer Index (PCI) according to Sugarbaker et al. and the score developed by the Arbeitsgemeinschaft Gynäkologische Onkologie (AGO), both of which have had a lasting influence on the assessment of the prognosis and on the adjuvant therapy of patients with primary and recurrent ovarian cancer. My doctoral thesis was supported in 2013 by the Berlin Cancer Society e.V. with the Ernst von Leyden grant. After the completion of my clinical training as a resident, I continue my career a consultant under the direction of Prof. Dr. med. Sven Becker in the Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics at University Hospital Frankfurt.

Previously, I have published several original works and book chapters in the field of gynecological oncology of different entities and participated in several national and international cancer congresses either as a lecturer or a participant. I keep my active membership in national societies as DGGG, AGO, DKG, AGE, AG-CPC, NOGGO, etc.

I have also been a member of ESGO since 2013 and of ENYGO since 2017 where I could build relationships with colleagues from other European countries. Furthermore, since 2019 as a part of authors I contribute on ENYGO LIFE Report from Germany.

On this occasion, I believe my position as a National Representatives (NATREP) would intensify and increase networking, to get in contact with the national and international experts and exchange ideas about for future cooperation, as well as it will also let us to organize webinars, workshops, and other scientific and social activities in/for Germany.

I would therefore be very happy to get your vote on the way as a NATREP for Germany.
