### Motivational Statement

It is a privilege and a great opportunity for me to present my application for the ENYGO National Representative of Italy.

After I took my residency degree in Obstetrics and Gynecology in Varese (Italy), I moved to Rochester (MN, USA), where I undertook a 2-years research fellowship in Gynecologic Oncology at the Mayo Clinic. Later on, I moved to Oxford (UK) for an NHS clinical fellowship in gynecologic oncology at the Oxford Cancer Center. Currently, I work as a consultant in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Women's and Children Hospital of Varese, and I cover the position of research associate at the University of Insubria.

During my training I had the chance to develop deep knowledge in the oncologic field and to gain the technical and surgical skills necessary for the gynecologic cancers' treatment.

Regarding research, I mainly focused on endometrial cancer and surgical related morbidity, and I'm author of more than 80 scientific articles in the gynecologic oncology field. I cultivated national and international relationships with several leading centers, and I had the opportunity of coordinating multicentric projects, some of them still ongoing.

I've been an ESGO-ENIGO member since 2017 and this has revealed an exciting experience and a great opportunity to interact with inspiring colleagues from all over the world.
